So you want to do a Visual Waste Audit?

What is a "Visual Waste Audit"?

A Visual Waste Audit is a procedure to help review waste generation, methods of disposal, waste characteristics and what could be improved.

To get your Visual Waste Audit started, here's what you need to do:

Step 1

Make sure you have the proper equipment.



Trash



Tarp, work gloves, a reflective vest, & a rake

Tip: Try to only grab trash in trash bags. Don't worry about loose trash you may find in trash cans!



Step 2

Dump out the trash onto the tarp and start separating the different types of trash.

Types of trash:

recyclable plastic, metals, glass, paper & cardboard, nonrecyclable trash, and organic waste.

Step 3

Once you have all the types of trash separated, take a picture and guestimate what percentage of each type of trash there is. Then, have your partner take a guestimate.





Ensure that you and your partner agree on the percentages. Then, record your percentages on your spreadsheet.

Step 4

Once done guestimating, rake all the trash back into a garbage bag for disposal.

Then, dispose of the collected trash as determined by your team.



Tip: I found it easiest to line a trash bag inside a small trash bin then rake the trash inside.





The tarp can then be easily folded for storage and won't smell like trash!

Step 5

Once finished doing your Visual Waste Audits, your tarp will be dirty and in need of being hosed off.
